Generally Recognized as Safe (GRAS) Statement

USA Food and Drug Administration

"GRAS" is an acronym for the phrase Generally Recognized as Safe. Pursuant to articles 201 (s) and 409 of the Federal Food, Drug and Cosmetic Act, any Substance that is added intentionally to food is a food additive, which is subject to review and prior approval by the FDA, unless the substance has been recognized, by qualified experts, as if it had been adequately demonstrated as safe under the conditions of its intended use, or that the use of the substance is excluded from the definition of a food additive.

The Purified Tara Germ "Protein" derived from a vegetable tree therefore does not affect human consumption, even if it is an innovative product and is therefore exempt from the usual food additive tolerance requirements of the Federal Law Food, Medications and Cosmetics (FFDCA, for its acronym in English).
